Classes A and B are OPEN TO ALL COMERS including Hare Hounds Staff and Whippers-in who MUST be in livery, have hounds entered in the subsequent classes and be ready for judging at 11.00am prompt.

The prize for classes A & B is a suitably inscribed Pair of Crystal Tumblers and a rosette.

The runner-up in each of these classes will receive a special prize of £10 and a rosette.

**Class C - the entrant of a Hound in ANY ensuing classes who has travelled the greatest distance to the Show**  
Winner will receive a Crystal Tumbler and a rosette

**Class D - Best Veteran Hound that has hunted for 5 seasons or more, either sex**  
Winner to receive a Crystal Tumbler and a rosette.

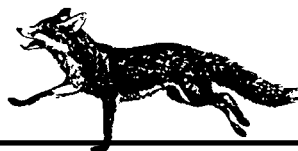

This is in memory of a most popular and much loved local young man who in his short life had achieved some notable successes and was highly thought of within the hunting fraternity. Also a crystal tumbler and rosette to keep.

**The Champion Fell Foxhound** will receive the Jim Kitching Trophy, presented for the first time in 2008, and the Syd Bruce Memorial Prize of a crystal tumbler and rosette.

**The Champion Foxhound at Lowther in 2008** drawn from the three champions will receive a Border Fine Arts Figurine plus a commemorative trophy of crystal which are won outright and a rosette. The hunt servant showing the hound will receive a crystal tumbler.

**The Reserve Champion Foxhound at Lowther in 2008** will receive a crystal trophy which is won outright and a rosette.
